HAYDN THE SEASONS

A line-up of outstanding soloists and top professional players join forces with Dulwich Choral Society to perform this hugely enjoyable oratorio

Saturday 11 December, 7.30pm

Haydn's last major work, *The Seasons* was written as a follow-up to his wildly popular *Creation*. Though less well known, this celebration of the four seasons is just as witty and exuberant, with brilliant depictions of everything from tipsy peasants and thunderstorms to croaking frogs and galloping huntsmen. Composed in 1801, the work stands right on the bridge of the classical and romantic ages, and through the emotions of three 'everyman' soloists, explores human mortality itself.
